Intent:

The motion itself is not clear in the minutes does not consider that the webmaster may be a member of Nar-Anon, or a group GSR; limiting participation (voice & vote) from a Nar-Anon Group or Nar-Anon member detailed in Guide to Local Services (possibly not supporting our Traditions and Concepts).

HISTORY: Motion of 2013.10.23: Website Committee Motion: "The motion was read and followed by a second. A question was asked as to whether or not the new Webmaster would be on the monthly phone call or not, but no answer could be given, but she would be part of the Website Committee call. It was shared that the previous webmaster did take part of the monthly teleconference calls but she also submitted a monthly report to the Region. Clarification was needed as to if the Committee was going to be no longer and the Web Master going to be fulfilling the full role. It was shared that if a Website Committee Chair was not voted in position in September, then the Committee would run without one. No further discussion followed. A roll call vote was taken: 11 yes and 1 abstention. Motion:

To rescind the motion, approved by the assembly of May 30, 2014, which states, "To add link for "**Do you need Nar-Anon?**" questions to the home page of the Florida Nar-Anon website with the verbiage underneath the link."

Intent:

To authorize the website committee to respond to and develop website wording, links, menus, page design, technology and NFG GLS and NFG Website Handbook changes.

Website committee intends to keep "Is Nar-Anon for Me?" wording replacing "Do You Need Nar-Anon?" with the same wording/link as Nar-Anon WSO. The committee will be able to place the link in an appropriate location on the FL Region website. If the title changes, the committee can change the title to the new title which should aide newcomers and lessen confusion over literature. Nar-Anon WSO website has webpage with a link titled, "Is Nar-Anon for Me?" (<http://nar-anon.org/what-is-naranon/>) which links to a document titled "20 Questions - Is Nar-Anon for Me?"

This is a different document than the CAL literature O-413 titled "20 Questions (document title is "Do You Need Nar-Anon?") and P-105 "Do You Need Nar-Anon?" and the O-406 literature titled Nar-Anon Offers Hope. (back 1/3 page of Hope pamphlet, "Do You Need Nar-Anon?*" (Excerpt taken from Do You Need Nar-Anon?"). All appear to have same questions. There can be copyright issues (we can reproduce 25% of a piece of literature.

Motion of May 30, 2014: "To add a link for the "Do You Need Nar-Anon?" questions to the home page of the FL Nar-Anon website with the verbiage underneath the link." Intent: "To aid those in search of the questions "do I need Nar-Anon?" utilizing the questions listed in the Hope pamphlet."
