## OPENING

## OFFICER REPORTS

- ASR – There is a FL Region Assembly Meeting Saturday, March 8. Members discussed the CAR motions and the lack of a tally sheet to show group’s vote on each motion. We believe that the tally sheet came from WSO and Theresa modified it for formatting and a special one for the region delegate to get a tally on each groups vote to access into a Region vote for each motion.
  1. Theresa will ask Yvette to be sent the 2025 CAR tally sheet
  2. Marguerite will ask/detail in her Bay Area Report:
    - 1) If there is a tally sheet for the Region Groups to use for CAR motions
    - 2) Where do the Groups send their voting tally sheet?
    - 3) What is the cut-off date for the Group CAR votes to be submitted?
    - 4) That the Bay Area donation to the region is smaller this time due to the large literature order we made earlier this year.
    - 5) Ask for region in-person assemblies to be hybrid for participation from members across Florida that may not have the ability to attend an in-person assembly.
    - 6) Ask for the return of the BA Nar-Anon banner that we lent the region months ago.
- Treasurer – Kevin reviewed the January Treasurer Report (attached).
  1. Theresa motioned to donate \$265 to the Region; Kevin seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

## REPORTS

- Literature Rep – The BA received the \$1540 Literature Order from WSO. The Bay Area has adequate stock of literature to last for many months.
- Outreach

    - Kevin ordered and received the acrylic literature racks from Amazon..
    - Theresa pointed out that in the March Edition of the FL Region NFG News, under Outreach News, a Nar-Anon Banner that was used at an Outreach Event may be our missing BA Nar-Anon banner that was not returned after we lent it out to the region. The BA has been unable to locate the banner. Marguerite will ask Bonnie about the banner to have it returned to the Bay Area.

Thank you for your support of our fellowship. The \$35,000 stated as needed each month is what is needed to meet our annual budget. Based on the fellowship meeting the goal in December and January, the supplies have been purchased to continue to print literature and we are at a backlog at the moment. It was decided we would not increase our prices at this time, because there is talk about an increased cost in the supply chain. Shipping cost has just increased. Also, many of the international countries' economies are unstable.

The Bay Area was pleased to see that funds were raised in January that met the WSO budget. Could you enlighten us on the source of those funds?

The Bay Area of Florida recognizes that requests for more donations to help Nar-Anon have previously been unmet. We also realize that sales of literature is a primary source of funds for Nar-Anon. The BA recommends that prices be increased for both royalty fees and all literature.

When do you anticipate the depletion of existing stock of literature will be completed?
