Access to conference approved literature CAL

Unity

Unity, through collective adherence to the program's principles and traditions and guided by the conscience of the group, can resolve challenges related to literature—including delays in publication and difficulty accessing approved literature. Regular rotation of service provides the foundation for recovery for all members. This unity begins at the group level and, through the selection of officers based on spiritual principles, extends to the area, region, other regions, and ultimately to World Service—a process that ensures stability and coordination throughout the entire service structure.

Healthy Meetings

What traits are indicative of a Healthy Meeting: telling 'war stories' vs talking about recovery; someone dominating the meeting vs everyone having an equal voice, etc. A healthy meeting fosters growth and recovery.

Free online participation in the conference

The accessibility and opportunity for each region to participate in shaping the fellowship's group conscience at the World Service Conference (WSC) put into practice key Program principles: Unity and Equality, and observing the Traditions and Concepts of Nar-Anon. The geopolitical situation does not allow paying the registration fee for many regions of Nar-Anon. This inclusive approach fosters genuine growth within the fellowship. Conducting the conference online eliminates expenses for visa processing, travel, accommodation, meals for participants, and printing of conference materials.

Consensus-based decision making

We assume that, according to the spiritual nature of our program and our traditions and concepts, it is the most appropriate way to make decisions. It is based on the spiritual principles of humility, goodwill, unity, respect, and acceptance.

Anonymity
