INVITATION TO REGISTER AND ATTEND THE INTERIM WORLD SERVICE CONFERENCE 2026 AS OBSERVERS

All Nar-Anon members are invited to register and attend the Nar-Anon Interim World Service Conference (IWSC) 2026 as observers. If you are not already registered as a Delegate, Alternate Delegate, member of the World Service Board, or a World Service Committee Chair, then [click this link](#) to register for the IWSC 2026 Conference.

Once you complete the registration, a Zoom link will be emailed to you. The link you receive will be uniquely created for you and will not work if you share it with another member. If another member also wants to observe, share the registration link above so they can receive their own unique Zoom link.

We suggest saving the Zoom link email where you can easily find it to use during the IWSC 2026 orientation sessions and conference. The email that contains that link will also include contact information should you need any assistance.

The IWSC 2026 conference will begin at 6:00 am PDT on Friday, April 24, Saturday April 25, and Sunday April 26, 2026. [This link will help you convert that time to your local time.](#)

The IWSC 2026 uses Zoom webinar, which is a different Zoom format than you typically experience when attending a virtual Nar-Anon meeting. When you attend as an observer, you will see and hear the IWSC 2026 but no one will see or hear you. In other words, observers are not able to interact with the participants of the IWSC.

We have found it is best to use a computer. It is possible to use a tablet or cell phone, but you will have a limited view than you would with a computer. With a computer, you will see what the Zoom host sees. With a tablet or cell phone, your device may change views as it follows the activity.

The IWSC 2026 is a multilingual event. We are using Zoom Translated Captions (ZTC) to convert what is spoken into text in the language you choose.

- You can access ZTC by selecting the option to "Show Captions."
- When you click on that option, Zoom should ask you to select the language you want to see.
- You need to only set this option once based on what language you want to read.
- Zoom will automatically translate what is spoken into the language you selected.
- If the captions are moving too quickly, you can choose the option to "View Full Transcript."
- On a computer, the full transcript will appear in a separate window. On a tablet or cell phone, the transcript will probably fill your screen and block your view of the other parts of the IWSC.
